(MPA) Master in Professional Accounting program Includes Graduate Certificate (4 subjects), Master Degree (12 subjects), Master Degree Extended (16 subjects).	\$2,547 Eligible for FEE-HELP
(MM) Master of Management programs Includes Graduate Certificate (4 subjects), Graduate Diploma (8 subjects) and Master Degree (12 subjects) Arts Management, Event Management, Sport Management and Tourism Management	\$2,172 Eligible for FEE-HELP
Community Management (not-for-profit sector) This program is commonwealth supported: the fees are subsidised and may vary from subject to subject.	Approx \$1107 Eligible for HECS-HELP
